

We are pleased to announce that we received the prestigious Gold Standard Award, a testament to our commitment to excellence and the profound impact of our programs. Our 90-day recruitment campaign, "It Takes Little to be Big," garnered an incredible 524 inquiries, demonstrating the community's dedication to mentoring and making a difference in the lives of its youth.

This year, we celebrated a historic milestone at the 20th Annual Brad Miller Gala, Auction, and Golf Outing, where we raised over \$1,000,000 for the first time in our agency's history. The William J. & Bonnie L. Hefner Foundation's incredible \$100,000 donation played a large part in making this outcome happen, along with our community's commitment to giving back, for which we could not be more grateful. Additionally, we hosted our inaugural Boo Bash at Brad Miller's place, providing a fun and memorable experience for our matches, with ample transportation to ensure everyone could participate.

We are excited to have launched our new High School Leadership program which creates meaningful matches between high school and grade school

students. This program is supported by a comprehensive curriculum designed to foster leadership skills and personal growth, shaping the next generation of active community participants.

Moreover, we received over \$80,000 in ARPA grants, which will be instrumental in rebuilding our volunteer pipeline. These funds will help us continue to recruit, train, and support the volunteers who are the heart of our mission.





FRANK ZIRILLE BIG BROTHERS BIG SISTERS SCHOLARSHIP FUND

“No child deserves less opportunity in life than any other child”

Frank Zirille was the first Executive Director of Big Brothers of Greater Fort Wayne, now Big Brothers Big Sisters of Northeast Indiana. He championed BBBS as its Executive Director for more than two decades from 1972 to 1994.

About the Frank Zirille BBBS Scholarship Fund

The Frank Zirille BBBS Scholarship Fund is a newly-formed scholarship program to be administered by Big Brothers Big Sisters of Northeast Indiana providing financial and other assistance for post-secondary education for graduating “Littles” in the BBBS program. The Scholarship Fund was formed as a “next step” in the journey of Littles and the continued conviction that all kids deserve the same opportunities in life for happiness and success.

Created in the memory of Frank Zirille, former CEO of Big Brothers Big Sisters, this scholarship aims to honor the passion and mission Frank took with him every day. Because of his humble upbringing, Frank had to work long and hard to get to where he ended up. His hard work was rewarded with a scholarship to Notre Dame. Paying it forward, the Zirille family wants to give the same opportunity to bright Littles who need an extra helping hand to go to college.

Specifically, the Scholarship Program will provide graduating Littles in the BBBS program with 4-year renewable scholarships to be used to cover the financial “gap” between financial aid received by a student and their total Cost of Attendance (COA) for their college or trade school including tuition, room & board, transportation, computer and other study materials, study abroad expenses, etc. The \$1,000,000+ Scholarship Fund is being

launched with local seed donations that, along with continuing fundraising efforts from the BBBS organization, are intended to last 10-15 years providing annual scholarships to over 100 area students!

Graduating high school Littles who meet minimum guidelines as to achievement, need, and promise will be eligible to apply for scholarships at the outset of their senior year. Recipients will be granted financial aid based on need taking into account their chosen institution’s COA and other scholarships and aid received. Recipients will be expected to maintain minimum grade point averages and good standing as a condition to scholarship renewal each year. Announcements for scholarship winners will be announced each spring as post-graduate decisions are made. Recipients of Frank Zirille BBBS Scholarships will also receive mentoring through the program including assistance with navigating campus and campus offerings, resume building, class and major selection, summer internship searches, etc. further carrying forward Big Brothers Big Sisters’ commitment that all students ought to have like opportunities for happiness and success.

The first recipient of the Frank Zirille BBBS Scholarship Fund was announced on May 31, 2023, at Big Brothers Big Sisters’ 50th Anniversary Gourmet Dinner and given to Little Brother Trevor Schill.

LAUNCH OF HIGH SCHOOL LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

The High School Leadership program engages high school students as peer mentors for elementary and middle school youth. High school mentors commit to spending 1 hour a week at the elementary school site with their mentee for a minimum of one school year (although most matches last longer). High school students will gain a friend and have fun with their Little by playing games, going on the playground, completing teacher-directed activities, and hanging out as a way to increase the mentee’s self confidence and help them with preteen issues. It’s really all about the Big and Little sharing who they are and building a consistent friendship.

When a high school student and a mentee are matched, they are not left on their own. Our staff works with the high school student to help them develop the coaching skills to help their mentee with school and peer relationships. Our staff also works with the mentee’s teachers and parents to make sure that the pair is working toward goals that are beneficial for the child.



West Noble High School and Elementary School joined hands September 21, 2023, for a new mentorship program that will allow high school students to bond with 3rd and 4th graders during seventh period once a week.

The program is a new version of Big Brothers Big Sisters’ long-running School Buddies program, where adult volunteers eat lunch with an elementary school student once a week. Volunteers have the opportunity to read books, play games, complete crafts, and get to know their new Little Brother or Sister.

“I became more comfortable with speaking to strangers. I have learned that young minds have so much more to offer than most people realize. I have also learned to cherish the little things like the time I spend with Allison in this program,” said one match.



Big Brothers Big Sisters of Northeast Indiana is only the third program in the nation to tee off a high school program. On October 31, 2023, Garrett schools joined West Noble with a leadership program of their own.

The West Noble program counts as a class credit toward the high schoolers’ Pathways. Each week, the matches will receive a lesson to help grow and build their relationship with each other.

The program plans to expand into more schools for the 2024-2025 school year with Columbia City joining early May 2024 to pilot the program in Whitley County.





BIG BROTHER RICK LITTLE BROTHER TREVOR

2023 Indiana State and Northeast Indiana Big Brother & Little Brother of the Year



Meet Big Brother Rick McCampbell and Little Brother Trevor Schill who became the 2023 Big Brother and Little Brother of the Year for Indiana after exemplifying the transformative power of mentorship, able to touch the lives of not only those involved but of everyone around them.

Their journey to a lasting and family-like relationship began in 2019, 5 years ago, when Trevor was 13 years old. Although he was clearly smart and responsible, Trevor's mom was worried about his quiet nature and his lack of a father figure in his life. After his parents' divorce, his father very quickly left Trevor and his brother behind, without a male role model to give the guidance and encouragement that a young boy needs. She was also worried about—and grateful for—the extra weight Trevor took on his shoulders from an early age by helping with his older brother Triston who has autism. Although he is younger, Trevor has acted as the older brother for Triston, giving him extra support and sticking up for him at school and during Unified track and football. Knowing Trevor needed support in a way she couldn't give, she signed him up for Big Brothers Big Sisters.

When these two met, Trevor was still quite quiet, but thankfully his Big Brother Rick was more than willing to fill the silence and keep the conversation going. With his many life stories, Rick made a purpose to show how he got through different life situations, teaching Trevor how to tackle problems. Despite considering

himself a Big Brother rather than a father figure, Rick filled the mentorship role that Trevor was missing. Rick had experience providing the love, support, encouragement, and life lessons that young boys need growing up. Little by little, Trevor opened up and began to feel more free to speak his mind than ever.

Along their years of mentorship, Trevor credits his Big Brother for helping him grow in confidence, do everything with a purpose, learn to be himself, and find his voice. He believes his relationship with Rick is like no other, pushing him to do his best. Whether paying him for yardwork or showing him how to be genuine to himself, Rick's mentorship has been a source of inspiration to Trevor, illustrating exactly how to be a good son, a gentleman, a confident leader, and to go out and leave his mark on the world.

And Trevor is doing exactly that. Without a complaint, Trevor has stepped up for his family as his mother and brother need more help than before. Now graduated, Trevor was one of the first recipients of the Frank Zirille Scholarship which aims to help fill the financial aid gaps and provide additional mentoring as Littles go into college. Using the extra support from this Zirille family and Big Brothers Big Sisters scholarship, Trevor is now attending Indiana Tech with plans to become a mechanical engineer.

Like a ripple in water, one boy's mentorship has gone on to affect so many more than just him.



With a plan and a purpose, Trevor is now hoping to change the lives of Littles just like him. Through a partnership with Indiana Tech and Big Brothers Big Sisters, Trevor started a student organization to bring other students to the cause. This eventually transformed into College Connections+, the newest of Big Brothers Big Sisters' programs which matches a college mentor with a Little.

Rick and Trevor's commitment to each other and their life-changing relationship is a perfect example of why Big Brothers Big Sisters does what it does, making them an obvious choice for Big Brother and Little Brother of Indiana State and Northeast Indiana. Their story paints a picture of the infinite ways mentorship changes the world, one Little at a time.



BIG SISTER JANIS LITTLE SISTER DESTINY

2023 Northeast Indiana Big Sister & Little Sister of the Year



Meet Big Sister Janis Davidson and Little Sister Destiny Ellington who became the 2023 Big Sister and Little Sister of the Year for Indiana after showcasing the positive effect of having someone to walk alongside you through life's many ups and downs and twists and turns.

Destiny's life in 5th grade when she met Janis was drastically different than it is now. Her home life was in disarray as two adults cared for 7 children in a 2 bedroom apartment. Throughout this time, her grandma was her rock, but she knew that she couldn't give Destiny the time and attention she needed. Because of this, she signed Destiny up to get a Big Sister, an extra friend who would take her out and give her one-on-one time.

Janis was just that person. As a source of added support, Janis was a relief to both Destiny and her grandma who struggled to care for everyone. Although Destiny was slow to warm up to her Big Sister, there was an immediate connection between them that would only strengthen over the course of several of life's trials.

When DCS stepped in to Destiny's life, she and her 3 siblings were separated from each other and their grandma. In the foster system, Destiny was able to continue seeing her Big Sister Janis, who remained a constant in a life full of upheavals.

Life took another turn when Destiny's grandma passed away. She, again separated from her siblings, went through 3 different foster homes before finding a stable life in the home of Cynthia McBride. Throughout it all, Destiny persevered and always found Janis as someone to lean on.

Their outings gave Destiny an outlet. For their very first match meeting, the two headed to the Dollar Store, buying a small backpack, pens, and a notebook. They used this pen pal kit to write down their thoughts and feelings to each other, the ones too difficult to share out loud, and would pass it back and forth at each outing.

Being matched with Janis also allowed Destiny to see her siblings, a major factor in keeping her family together. Janis would host Destiny and her siblings to hang out at her house and soon the whole bunch became one big family along with Janis' son and daughter-in-law and Destiny's foster family.

One last unexpected surprise came in the form of a baby. First finding out she was pregnant at 16, Destiny had all the emotions that come along with this kind of news. Nervous and scared, she was happy to find that Janis supported and accepted her as she embarked on her new life journey as a single mother. The week Destiny brought her son Jordan home, Janis' son and daughter-in-law visited with their own child. In a room full of nothing but love, Destiny knew she had a family in the Davidsons.



After graduating with academic honors and enrolling at PFW, Destiny goes on to chase her dream of becoming a lawyer. Throughout it all, Janis remains in awe of Destiny's endurance and peace as she navigates through the unexpected. Destiny credits Janis' care, love, and support for her ability to get through it.

Big Brothers Big Sisters brought these two ladies together, leaving them with an incredible bond and a larger family than before. Throughout life's unexpectedness, they treasure their sisterhood and ability to walk alongside each other throughout the journey, making it crystal clear why they are the 2023 Big Sister and Little Sister of the Year for Indiana State and Northeast Indiana.



IT TAKES LITTLE TO BE BIG

Fifty years ago, our Big Brothers Big Sisters chapter opened with humble success. At the time, 27 matches was commendable and a record for the newly-opened agency. Now, 50 years later, Big Brothers Big Sisters of Northeast Indiana is one of the leading chapters of BBBS in the country.

With over 30,000 youth served and a 90% graduation rate, BBBS's success has had a lasting impact on the community, inspiring generation after generation to continue its work and mission. Mentoring helps youth rise above their circumstances (many face poverty, have incarcerated parents, or have lost a parent) and become active members of the community themselves, often becoming volunteers or donors. The dedication seen by its staff, with two CEOs serving over 20 years each, and the commitment to empowering youth from our volunteers have no doubt played a huge role in the agency reaching 50 successful years.

Through Mission Every One, Macy's fundraised a whopping \$4.3 million along with \$400k in grants. All these proceeds went to helping youth across the nation find the support they need and reach their full potential in one-to-one mentorships.





CELEBRATING 20 YEARS OF BRAD MILLER GALA, AUCTION, AND GOLF OUTING

What better way to spend the summers than on the golf course, soaking up sun, and breathing fresh air? For Brad Miller, 2-time NBA All-Star and former Little, there's nothing better. Originally from Kendallville, now that he retired from basketball, he likes to spend as much time as he can on his Indiana property in Steuben. One BIG way he spends his summers is through giving back to the organization that helped steer him in the right direction by introducing him to his Big Brother Dewy Forbes.

Growing up, Brad didn't have much opportunity to explore the great outdoors or learn sports. That is until he met Dewy. His Big Brother introduced him to many sports and fostered his love of basketball, the sport that would launch him into the successful retired player he is today. Because of Dewy, he also grew a fondness for the outdoors which is seen through his 600+ acres of land used for fishing, hiking, and hunting today. This love of the outdoors is shared with youth through the Brad Miller Campout, a camping extravaganza hosted by the outdoors connoisseur on his land. Now, he has his own show, Country Boys Outdoors, that he uses to showcase his love of nature.

After a successful basketball career and retirement, Brad now gives back to BBBS through hosting the Brad Miller Gala, Auction, and Golf Outing, which he has been doing for the past 20 years! His goal is to create the same opportunities for the new generation of Littles that he was provided himself. Rather than rely on funding from the national BBBS branch, he took it upon himself to fundraise the money needed to support matches. Most years there are almost 1,000 donors who attend the functions, and each year the amount earned grows.

However, the 20th anniversary of the Brad Miller events in 2023 was one for the books! With over 1,000 people

attending, Brad and the BBBS team had a lofty goal: to surpass their last year's earnings of \$900k and reach \$1 million. With such a dedicated team, and a special after-gala live concert performance by Clayton Anderson, BBBS was able to raise \$1 million in just one day! This was only possible through our community's inspiration to make a difference and commitment to give back — and in large part due to the William J. & Bonnie L. Hefner Foundation's incredible \$100,000 donation. What a perfect way to celebrate two decades of Brad Miller's genuine philanthropy and special fundraisers to serve the Northeast Indiana communities.





BUILDING MUSCLE AND A LASTING BOND

When the BFit program first started, it had many goals to combat some serious problems facing Northeast Indiana. Our state faces high rates of obesity, along with high rates of children going hungry. Big Brothers Big Sisters saw this and created the BFit program to address a need in the community for health and wellness education.

They did this through designing activities and educational experiences for matches to attend and learn about physical, nutritional, and emotional health. Aided by Purdue University's Health and Wellness Department, Littles were provided a nutritional course along with activities that



bring kids to their feet and get them moving. In years past, their goals included bringing in physicians and local businesses to further educate on these topics as well as give children opportunities to learn about healthy choices in the kitchen, expose themselves to new healthy food, and teach them how to cook balanced meals.

BFit flourished in 2023, continuing several key initiatives throughout the year. "Kids in the Kitchen" instructed attendees on how to prepare healthy meals and snacks, allowing them to develop culinary skills and healthy habits along the way. "Movement and Munchies" combined lessons about exercise and nutrition. This program involves cuisine from different cultures as well as traditional dance instruction for added cultural education. "The Doctor Is In" addresses one of the previous year's goals to give participants the chance to ask healthcare

professionals questions and learn about their health in a comfortable and accessible environment. Other popular activities included PFW CATCH Nutrition, open gyms, yoga, dodgeball, HEAL Dinner & Drawing, basketball camps, gymnastics events, field days, and zoo hiking.

Throughout the year, BBBS staff oversaw 110 activities. Proving its success, BFit programs attracted 1,716 attendees in total. BBBS continued with its goals to provide health education and fun exercise activities. They also completed their goal of partnering with others in the community who support getting kids healthy such as PFW, Bishop Dwenger High School, and local health professionals.



MENTORING A GREENER FUTURE WITH CONSERVATION BUDDIES

In a world where technology is everywhere and always advancing, people's lives can easily become consumed by it. You can find screens at school, work, home, and almost anywhere a Wi-Fi signal can reach. Conservation Buddies comes at the perfect time, aiming to introduce children to the natural world and give them the tools and knowledge to protect it. Through this program, children learn about environmental conservation, restoration, protection, and outdoor activities which get them outside and exploring nature. Many children have not had the opportunity to have these experiences, and Conservation Buddies makes moves to remedy this. Especially for at-risk youth, the outdoors can offer solace and peace, a calm and open environment perfect for learning.

Started by the 2020 Northeast Indiana Big Couple of the Year, Charita and Andrew Niedermeyer, Conservation Buddies has a full schedule of year-round activities Bigs and Littles can participate in such as fishing, camping, hiking, kayaking, safe shooting, wildlife learning, archery, and gardening.

The program kicked off in 2021, in part from a generous donation of \$5,000 from NIPSCO and NiSource Charitable Foundation. However, 2022 brought even further support and recognition of the program's merits with a \$50,000 donation from NIPSCO and NiSource Charitable Foundation to support Conservation Buddies over the next two years. A plan was formed to use these funds for 2 years' worth of supplies and equipment, 2 overnight campouts for 50 matches, 20 conservation-based activities, and 10 new matches served.



Big Brothers Big Sisters is proud to say that the program has continued meeting

its goals and promoting environmental learning in 2023. Thus far, the program has had 12-15 attendees (Bigs, Littles, and waitlist Littles) for each of its 15 activities. Additionally, BBBS hosted 1 overnight campout during this first year of the plan. To continue its mission, BBBS has also taken measures to recruit more Conservation Buddy Bigs as well as make more community partners, opening up even more opportunities for our Littles. The program's leaders have already begun this by partnering with Friends of the Rivers so Littles can learn about river health and storm drain cleaning.
